SAFETY SAFARI BY DON

Basic Tenets of First Aid are to be done.

1. (inform consent] Always ask the person if you can help them..
2. [airway] Are they breathing or is the airway open: how can you tell, are they able to talk. if they are talking the are breathing.
3. [circulation] Is their a pulse, if they are awake and responsive, they have a pulse.
4. [Sub-section] check for bleeding. You may need to apply pressure over injured area.
At the same time as above, check your area to see if you are safe [out of harms way]
Do not move the victim unless a life threatening situation is about to happen or you feel there may happen, this could cause further injury. Ask if anyone called 911, have a second person call.
5. [spinal precautions] immobilize the victim, so they can not their head or back.

So we have the ABC safety and spinal check list, do this in this order and reevaluate every 5 minutes in same order. Make sure you check to see if anyone talked to 911 and did they have an ETA.

Remember to be calm, be sensitive and reassuring. this could be you! Basic common sense can save your Life or the Life of another.

I hope this issues helps. Remember ; Be Prepared
