

### **SAFETY SAFARI By Don Saewert**

In the best of all worlds the temperature would always be 78 degrees, the wind would be at our backs, and no emergencies would arise.

Since it is a slightly imperfect world we live in, we should be prepared for whatever happens.

#### Emergency Braking

Sometimes you have to stop as quickly as possible. Here are some tips on how to get you and your motorcycle halted pronto!

1. Apply both brakes to their maximum, just short of locking them up. Practice in an open, good-surfaced place, such as a clean parking lot.
2. Keep the motorcycle upright and traveling in a straight line; and look where you're going, not where you've just been.
3. If your rear wheel locks up, do not release the brake. If your handlebars are straight, you will skid in a straight line, which is all right.

Your most important priority is to get stopped !
